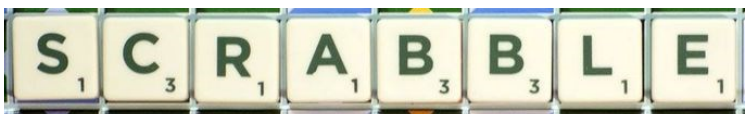


Exciting Upgrades Coming to Our Library!
